Dear Lasalliana Readers,

This Issue Number 13 will also be the last one to appear. The number of subscriptions should be sufficient to cover the cost of printing the LASALLIANA.

This had been the case during the first year of its appearance. Subsequently, the fluctuation in the dollar's rate of exchange, the progressive diminution in the number of subscriptions, the normal increase in production costs have made it impossible to cover expenses, despite two successive increases in the annual subscription price.

After studying this situation and taking into consideration the prospects for the year 1987-88, the General Council decided last June to stop further publication with Issue Number 13.

During the course of the last four years, the LASALLIANA has tried to make the diversity and richness of Lasallian activities and initiatives throughout the world better known. At the same time, it has presented some aspects of the life and thoughts of Saint John Baptist de La Salle. It was thus a place of mutual convergence and knowledge, an instrument of exchange and a contributing factor of interdependence and communion for us all. Thanks to the LASALLIANA,

quite a number of Brothers and lay people were able to express their views, at the Institute level, thus contributing to illustrate what we call "together and by association".

This final presentation is for me, therefore, the occasion for warmly congratulating and thanking all those who have contributed to the existence and to the interest in this review:

* the authors of articles for their availability and contributions;

* the faithful subscribers who showed their interest and confidence;

* those who read and made use of the articles;

* those in Rome who handled the correspondence with the authors, kept track of the subscriptions, translated the texts, did the proof reading, posted the issues, etc..

For the style and form of the LASALLIANA was truly a shared and fraternal endeavour.
