INTRODUCTION

We have received many letters expressing satisfaction that LASALLIANA is once again back in print. This is hardly surprising when one realises just how many requests were sent to the General Council asking for it to resume publication.

– We should like to remind readers that **each issue of Lasalliana** consists of **20 articles** in loose-leaf form. Articles are classified according to one or other of six headings, each heading identified by a capital letter:

- O.** General topics, miscellaneous subjects.
- A.** St. John Baptist de La Salle: life, writings, spirituality, teachings, etc.
- B.** The Institute: past and present.
- C.** Education.
- D.** The Institute working with lay people. The Lasallian Family.
- E.** Accounts of personal experiences, events, celebrations.
In case of need, new headings can be created.

– **Numbering of articles.**

The system of numbering articles offers various possibilities with regard to classification and retrieval. Up till now, articles were identified by two numbers and a letter, e.g: 14 - B - 74, where 14 stood for the number of the issue; B indicated that the article came under the heading B, the Institute; 74 indicated that the article was the 74th published under the B heading.

It has been suggested that it would be a good idea to give each article a further number, indicating its place in the issue and providing a means of checking to see if there are any articles missing.

This explains why as from now we are going to insert a place-in-the-issue number immediately after the issue number. For example: 15 - 3 - A - 63 refers to issue 15, article 3, heading A, 63rd article under this heading.

– The **Aims of LASALLIANA** are to provide information on Lasallian topics and on our educational apostolate; to suggest areas for reflection and study; and to provide material for meetings, study groups, etc.

Its articles are intended for all the various members of the Lasallian Family. Some articles will, of course, be of more use to some groups than to others. We are convinced that each community, each school, each Lasallian group, etc. should have its disposal one or more copies of this publication.

There are still **copies available** of all but a few **past issues**.

– Recently there was published the **Letter to the Lasallian Family**, which the last General Chapter had requested from the Superior General and his Council.

Such an important document deserves a lot of attention. In the next issue (No. 16 which comes out in October 1989), there will be a number of articles dealing with this Letter.
