INTRODUCTION

LASALLIANA BEGINS A NEW YEAR.

LASALLIANA begins a third year in the second period of its existence.

In the first period, 13 issues were published, at the rate of 3 per year, and these were obtained by individual subscriptions. Publication ceased on account of certain difficulties that had arisen. The General Council, however, received many letters from all over the Institute deploring its disappearance. Those who made use of Lasalliana knew how useful it was.

The General Council saw from the letters it had received how much the publication was missed and requested publication to be resumed. And so it was that issue N°. 14 appeared in January 1989 as an Institute publication. Since then two years have come and gone and the third is beginning.

- Brothers and Brothers' communities
- Staff of Lasallian schools
- Lay staff who work with us in our educational apostolate
- Members of the Lasallian Family.

WHAT IS THE AIM OF LASALLIANA?

- To provide **information** and **thought-provoking** material about
 - The Holy Founder: his life, work and spirituality
 - The Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools
 - The vocation and consecrated life of the Brother
 - The educational apostolate, the shared apostolate, the educational service of the poor, the Lasallian Family.
 - Pedagogical topics (education, methodology) with special reference to our own schools.
- To **describe things** that have been done:
 - Of a religious, educational, pastoral nature, etc., in the Lasallian world.
 - In the way of missionary activity, Lasallian Voluntary Service, schemes to improve living conditions and to promote religion, etc.

WHO CONTRIBUTES TO LASALLIANA?

- LASALLIANA accepts contributions from all sections of the Lasallian world: Brothers, communities, lay teachers, friends, etc. Anyone who wants to can write in and his contribution will be welcome.
- LASALLIANA also asks certain specific people to write articles for it.

HOW IS LASALLIANA DISTRIBUTED?

- **Formerly**, LASALLIANA was obtained by individual or community subscriptions. **THIS IS NO LONGER THE CASE.**
- **At present**, it is the **District** that sends in the subscription. That is to say, **the Visitor informs** the Generalate (the Secretary General) how many copies the District requires.

The District distributes copies to communities, schools and to those persons for whom the publication would be useful. Sometimes there is a case for sending copies to people outside the Lasallian Family who are not aware of the publication's existence and therefore cannot ask for it.

Districts are asked to stimulate the demand for this Institute publication which has been thought out and prepared for the purpose of sharing thought-provoking material, knowledge, and information about happenings in the Lasallian world. It is up to the Brothers, communities, Lasallian schools, etc. No one should be left out. We have a very good tool at our disposal and we should use it. Thank you to those who make our work easier.
