INTRODUCTION

● This issue of *Lasalliana*, N22, is the last one of 1991. With it, **the third year of publication** (second period) comes to an end. (After the first period, publication was discontinued for two years.)

● This year, the Institute is celebrating the tercentenary of the **heroic vow** made by St. John Baptist de La Salle and two of his companions. By it they committed themselves before God and for his greater glory, to support the young Society, and they declared themselves ready to face all sorts of sacrifices resulting from poverty and desertion. This act of generosity was blessed by God and had important consequences for the Church, for evangelisation and education. In this year's three issues we have included a certain number of articles relating to this event, treating it from an historical, spiritual and community point of view.

● This year also saw the publication of the **Guide for Formation**. This had been asked for by the last General Chapter and the finished product is the fruit of much hard work all over the Institute. This important document will be studied in a variety of articles in future issues of *Lasalliana*.

● 1991 was likewise the **centenary of "Rerum Novarum"**, an encyclical whose pastoral influence was very great in the sphere of labour relations. Pope John Paul II commemorated the occasion by publishing another striking document, the encyclical "Centesimus annus".

In future issues, we intend to offer some considerations on this matter. Our Institute, in fact, is much involved with working people, either by training students for trades, or running youth associations based on schools or establishments offering technical and vocational teaching.

● This year began shortly after the publication of "**Redemptoris Missio**" (it appeared on December 7th 1990). This encyclical calls on the Church as a whole to commit itself resolutely and seriously to evangelisation in all parts of the world.

Lasallian schools have to respond to this call. There has already been a number of articles on the subject. Others are in the pipeline for future issues.

● The **42nd General Chapter** has been officially announced. This means that the Institute will be preparing for this important event. We too will be considering it.

● As can be seen, all these various topics concern not only the Brothers, but **also the Lasallian Family** as a whole, that is, all those that belong to movements that have grown up around the Institute and who live according to Lasallian spirituality and the Lasallian charism of Christian education.

Certain Districts have asked for extra copies of *Lasalliana* so as to be able to supply not only communities, but also Lasallian schools, staffrooms, all kinds of Lasallian associations, affiliated members, collaborators, etc. This will be of great benefit to them. We thank them for the interest they show in this publication and we hope their example will be followed!
