INTRODUCTION

Use these gifts you have received with care and vigilance in order to fulfil the main duty of fathers and mothers towards their children" (Med. 139,2).

1994 would be a good opportunity to try to put into practice what the Holy Founder says.

- Our thanks once again for all your contributions to Lasalliana. We remind you that we welcome articles not only from Brothers, but also from all members of the Lasallian Family. Likewise, we would like the riches we Brothers share to be available also to all our colleagues in the shared mission.
