INTRODUCTION

- The current number 32 of *Lasalliana* begins a new year of publication with will encompass up to and including number 34.

- Number 31 of *Lasalliana*, devoted to a single subject, 232 pages in length, was dedicated to the Lasallian Chronology and corresponded to September-December, 1994. This number appeared in French and Spanish in July and was distributed before September. Nevertheless, the English edition was not available until now due to translation delays. It has now been completed and will be distributed soon.

This number has been well received and is highly valued as a work tool for the study of the life of the founder judging from the many comments that have been received and for which we are grateful.

This effort has been considerable due to the size of the work. That is why number 31 has been selected to be the special issue, as has been the custom for the past 3 years.

- The 42nd General Chapter of 1993 has determined that 1995 is to be a year of Prayer Renewal. The General Council has prepared materials that you all communities will receive and therefore we will not include articles about this theme in the ordinary LASALLIANA issues. But the special theme for that year will be on the single theme "The prayer life of the Brother - The spirituality of the Brother", as a special contribution to the Year of Prayer.

- Again we remind you that LASALLIANA is a publication open to all members of the Lasallian Family and is not intended exclusively for Brothers. We are aware that in many places our lay colleagues read and use it, especially our lay teachers. We are glad to hear this and hope that the circulation grows ever wider.

- The contributions that are received are many and of high quality. Because of the many articles received sometimes their publication is not possible as quickly as we would like. We are sincerely grateful for all contributions and we repeat our intent to be open to all contributions that adhere to the publication criteria whether these are from Brothers or from other members of our Lasallian Family.
